HOW DO BIRDIES MEAN BUCKS?

Say you pledge one cent per birdie and 1,500 birdies are made. After the tournament, you'll receive an invoice for \$15.00 from Thunderbirds Charities. You can either make your check payable to "Thunderbirds Charities" or provide credit card information. (Do not pay charity directly). For other possible pledge amounts, check chart at right.
